Now in the second year in our National English Hub designation we are delighted to be running a series of free showcase events demonstrating best practice in the teaching of phonics and early literacy. These are half day events that enable to see practise and discuss the teaching of systematic synthetic phonics and promoting a love of reading.



Showcases include:

- Introduction –who is the new look Hub?
- What is systematic synthetic phonics (SSP) and what does that look like in schools?
- Tour of the school to see phonics and reading in action
- The importance of developing a culture and love of reading in the school
- Commitment, fidelity and dedication to one scheme, the use of fully decodable books and resourcing.
- Receipt of the action planning documentation-submission required along with self evaluation for funding to be reimbursed
